- Program designed to allow each new Scout to advance to the First Class rank and earn the First Aid merit badge by the end of his first year.
- First year Scouts participate in all Troop outings and activities including summer camp.
- Separate patrols for First Year Scouts- integrated patrols in subsequent years/outings. Assistant Scoutmasters and Troop Guides are assigned to first year patrols.
- Assistant Scoutmasters monitor individual progress of each Scout.
- Program kicks off in March following the Webelos crossover.
